Snow Removal – Mowing - Driveway Clearance - Road Right-A-Way

- Do not push snow from private driveways into roadways or right-of-way ditches. Violations will be cited under Wisconsin Statutes 88.01, 86.07, 346.94 & 941.30. This ensures emergency vehicle access and public safety.
- Do not mow or push debris into roadways, this a violation of Wisconsin Statute § 346.94(5).
- Please keep your driveway clear of clutter and debris so that emergency vehicles such as police, fire or EMS may enter and exit unencumbered.
- Residents paving or cementing their driveways to the roadway. If the driveway becomes damaged at end of road. Town is not liable due to the road right-a-way.

Dog Licenses:

According to Wisconsin State Statutes, all dogs MUST be licensed and have a current rabies shot. Proof of immunization by a veterinarian must be presented to the treasurer at the time of obtaining a license. Dog licenses will not be issued without such proof. A new license is required for each dog every year by April 1st.



License fees payable with the application:

- \$10.00 for each male and female dog over the age of five (5) months unless spayed or neutered.
- \$5.00 for each spayed or neutered dog.
- \$5.00 delinquent fee paid after April 1st
- \$35.00 Kennel License required for a property with more than four dogs (aged 5 months or more) in addition to each license for each dog.

Notice to Businesses and Residents in the Town of Farmington

Wisconsin State Law requires that no less than 25% of your solid waste be recycled. You are required by law to separate your recyclables from your trash. (Wisconsin Statutes, Chapter 287) and Wisconsin Administrative Code (Chapters NR 542 to 549).

Example of items to recycle and that are banned from landfills:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean Glass jars and bottles with lids and rings removed.• Clean Metal cans with labels removed.• Clean #1-#7 recyclable Plastic containers.• Lead Batteries.• Waste oil and filters.• Lithium-Ion Batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Newspapers, Magazines, Books, Printed Media, bundled, tied securely or bagged.• Corrugated Cardboard flattened• All Metal items including tin, iron, steel, aluminum containers and cans and bi-metal products.• Large and small electric tools, electrical wiring, appliances and extension cords.• Yard waste like grass clippings, brush under 6" in diameter and leaves should be composted at home.

The Green Box and Recycling Site:

is located 1 mile west of Hwy B – take Switzke Road to Ranch Road. It is open each 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month from 8a.m. – Noon. Closed if a holiday.



NO DUMPING DURING CLOSED HOURS. VIOLATORS WILL BE FINED!

Green Box Fees are regulated by the onsite operator and may be subject to change at any time.

- \$5.00 for up to 3 Bags or 1 Barrel
- \$8.00 per automotive tire off the rim, more for oversize tires.
- \$15.00 for a couch, oversized chair and ALL major appliances such as stove, Oven, water heater, washer, dryer, dishwasher, microwave, water softener, water heater, humidifier or similar devices.
- \$15.00 for mattress, bed or box spring, large rugs (carpet may be donated to Y's Way in Watertown)
- \$25.00 for all refrigeration, freezers, electric coolers, air conditioning, dehumidifiers (coolants)
- \$3.00 per "household" electronic devices such as: Computers (desktop, laptop, tablets, keyboards, scanners, speakers, printers, DVD/VCR/CD players, fax machines and devices that plug into a computer. Operators' discretion to charge more for large items.
- \$35.00 for all Televisions, Computer Monitors or similar devices.

Residents are responsible for separating recyclables from trash prior to arrival and containers free of debris and triple rinsed.

Landlords are responsible to inform tenants of the recycling requirements for Town of Farmington
