(4) Minutes of the April 15, 2025 Annual Meeting of Electors

(5) 2025 Financial Report /CliftonLarsonAllen LLP

Chairman read Revenues and Expenditures for the 2025 Audit. Clerk stated this is a draft copy provided by Auditor Michael Bahr and when final review is done will mail out hard copy for all Board members.

A motion was made by Bill Nelson to approve draft and noted Clerk to review that no changes were made on draft when final is sent, seconded by Jim Baneck. Motion carried unanimously.

(6) Farmington Baseball U.A. Update and Budget Appropriation

Mr. Fred Lamp, President of Farmington Baseball U.A. present to give updates as follows:

- ✓ Registration done with 100 players and 20 Rock River. Total of 12 teams, mentioned a lot for T-Ball (4 teams), Junior Pee Wee Plus, Little League, Pony, Softball 12U & 13U.
- ✓ New toilets and auto faucets put in which is a great investment.
- ✓ New pavilion 30x30 with a "Thank You" to Emrath Construction.
- ✓ New cement under pavilion with the monies received from Town of Farmington.
- ✓ Fan Day will be Saturday June 27th honoring Arnie and Carmen Winkleman.
- ✓ Memorial Day in remembrance of Chad Rouhoff.
- ✓ The park receives requests for use of park for parties and can be used for other functions.
- ✓ Lakeside Lutheran just used ballpark and Maranatha still uses.
- ✓ This year hosting Junior Pee Wee Plus tournament weekend July 17th & 18th.

Mr. Lamp thanked the township for support.

A motion was made by Jody Schutte to approve same as last year appropriated funds in the amount of \$4,000.00 to the Farmington Baseball U.A. for 2027, seconded by Dale Weis. Motion carried unanimously.

(7) Johnson Creek Public Library Appropriation

Chairman stated that the director of the library recently attended Board meeting to thank the township and purchased games, electronic and wonder books. A motion was made by Denise Nelson to approve same as last year in the amount of \$1,500.00 for education programs to the Johnson Creek Public Library, seconded by Scott Sukow. Motion carried unanimously.

- Saucer Road to be worked on, split cost with Town of Watertown.
- Switzke Road to work on.
- Looking at S. Farmington Road but price came in high, so will have to revisit at later date to make decision on.
- Marsh Road done last year and received many compliments.

Mr. Jody Schuette commented on Christberg Road that County did last year good quality but did increase height of road.

(9) Set Elected Officials Wages & Per Diem for 2027-2029 term

Clerk provided wages from other townships and with the help of Mr. Jody Schutte was able to show on TV screen to have everyone see. The wages were discussed with everyone in attendance. A motion was made by Fred Lamp to increase each Board member by \$500.00, seconded by Jim Baneck. After discussion Fred Lamp rescinded previous motion and motioned to increase Chairman and Supervisors wage by \$500.00 and increase Treasurer and Clerk wage by \$750.00, seconded by Jody Schutte. Motion carried unanimously.

(10) Comments from Electors

Mr. Jody Schutte commented on roof issue with ceiling tiles damaged. Chairman stated will be reviewing. Clerk mentioned funds are available to repair with ARPA monies.

Mr. Jim Baneck commented on maintaining roads, which the town does a good job on.

(12) Adjournment


A motion was made by Dale Weis to adjourn the annual meeting, seconded by Jody Schutte. Motion carried to adjourn at 7:45p.m.


